HOW DOES IT WORK?

BUILT ON STRONG RELATIONSHIPS

Your child will meet weekly with a trained "child associate" whose role is to build a positive, supportive relationship.

SHORT TERM

Your child will participate for 12-15 sessions. Pre-K students meet twice a week for individual, play pair, and classroom sessions.

PLAY-BASED

Child associates use a play-based approach in a dedicated playroom. This approach helps build decision-making skills, resilience and confidence.
