Tabulated Results of a Survey of CPSE Directors

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During May and June, 2016, Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) chairs in New York State were invited to participate in a survey intended to assess the types and extent of service delivery problems school districts encounter when providing services to preschool children. The survey was developed with the input of CPSE chairs, directors of direction centers, directors of EPK, UPK, and PPK programs, members of the Roc the Future –School Readiness Collaborative Action Network, and evaluators from the Children’s Institute, which is affiliated with the University of Rochester. Invitations to complete the on-line survey were sent directly to CPSE chairs and to school district superintendents, with a request that the invitation be forwarded to the CPSE chair. To increase the response rate, follow-up reminders were sent one week prior to, three days prior to, and on the day of the close of the survey.

A copy of the survey appears in Appendix 1.

Invitations were sent to 738 NYS school districts and 37 BOCES districts. Valid responses were received from 247 districts, a 32% response rate.

Respondents were asked to specify their roles in the district. More than one role could be indicated. A large majority identified themselves as either CPSE or CSE chairs.

The results of the survey are presented in the tables and charts below. Survey item names are abbreviated for formatting reasons. A full glossary of survey items may be found in Appendix 2.

The number of children in the pre-K cohort for each district was assumed to be similar to the kindergarten enrollment for the current (2015-2016) school year. The table below shows the proportions of preschool children currently receiving special education programs and services. Results are reported both as average percentages of individual responses (i.e., each district is equally weighted) and as the proportions of total counts (i.e., averages weighted by district enrollment).





Providers accepting children only if IEP's meet certain criteria



Providers to use "clinic time" for services beyond the classroom time, and get reimbursed for classroom and clinic time




The typical length of delay before obtaining evaluation services was explored.

Typical length of delay before getting evaluation services








